NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

- 1.1.** The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2021-2024, the Hobie Class Rules, the Sailing Instructions, and this Notice of Race.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1.** This is a 'Points Regatta' as described by the Hobie Class Association of North America.
- 2.2.** This event is open to all Hobie Classes. As per Class rules, one crew member on each boat must be a member in good standing of the HCA.

- 2.3.** Members of the Sail Sand Point community may also participate in the Wave Class.
- 2.4.** Eligible boats may enter by registering at the registration desk during the registration window.

3. ENTRY AND ENTRY FEE:

- 3.1.** Registration closes Saturday, September 16th at 1100.
- 3.2.** Each competitor must have a signed Sail Sand Point Participation Waiver which can be found at the following link:

- 3.3.** An entree fee of \$20 payable with cash, credit, debit, or check which will be accepted the morning of Saturday, September 16th prior to registration ending at 1100.

4. CHARTERS:

- 4.1.** SSP will provide Hobie Waves on a first come, first serve basis.
- 4.1.1.** Sailors may charter waves through the Open Boating Program on a first come first serve basis, emailing rentals@sailsandpoint.org and requesting the use of a Wave for this event through the Open Boating Program.

5. MEASUREMENTS:

- 5.1.** Each boat shall comply with the International Hobie Class Rules and may be subject to inspection at any time during the regatta.

6. SCHEDULE:

6.2. Any changes to the schedule will be posted on the Official Notice Board located by the Sail Sand Point office.

7. RACING AREA:

7.1. All races will be sailed on the northern part of lake Washington, north of the 520 Bridge. Boats can launch from the beach and hand-launch ramps at the North Shore Recreation Area by Sail Sand Point on the north end of Magnuson Park.

8. TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION:

8.1. Sailors are responsible for their own transportation and housing.
